In 1993, Ozone depleting CFC refrigerants were banned, but there are still detrimental effects to global warming if refrigerant is released into the atmosphere. New legislation has made it illegal to work with refrigerants without approved training and certification. Laserchill already operates within these guidelines and has done since being established. Our team of experts are trained in the safe handling of refrigerants used in air conditioning and refrigeration systems.
